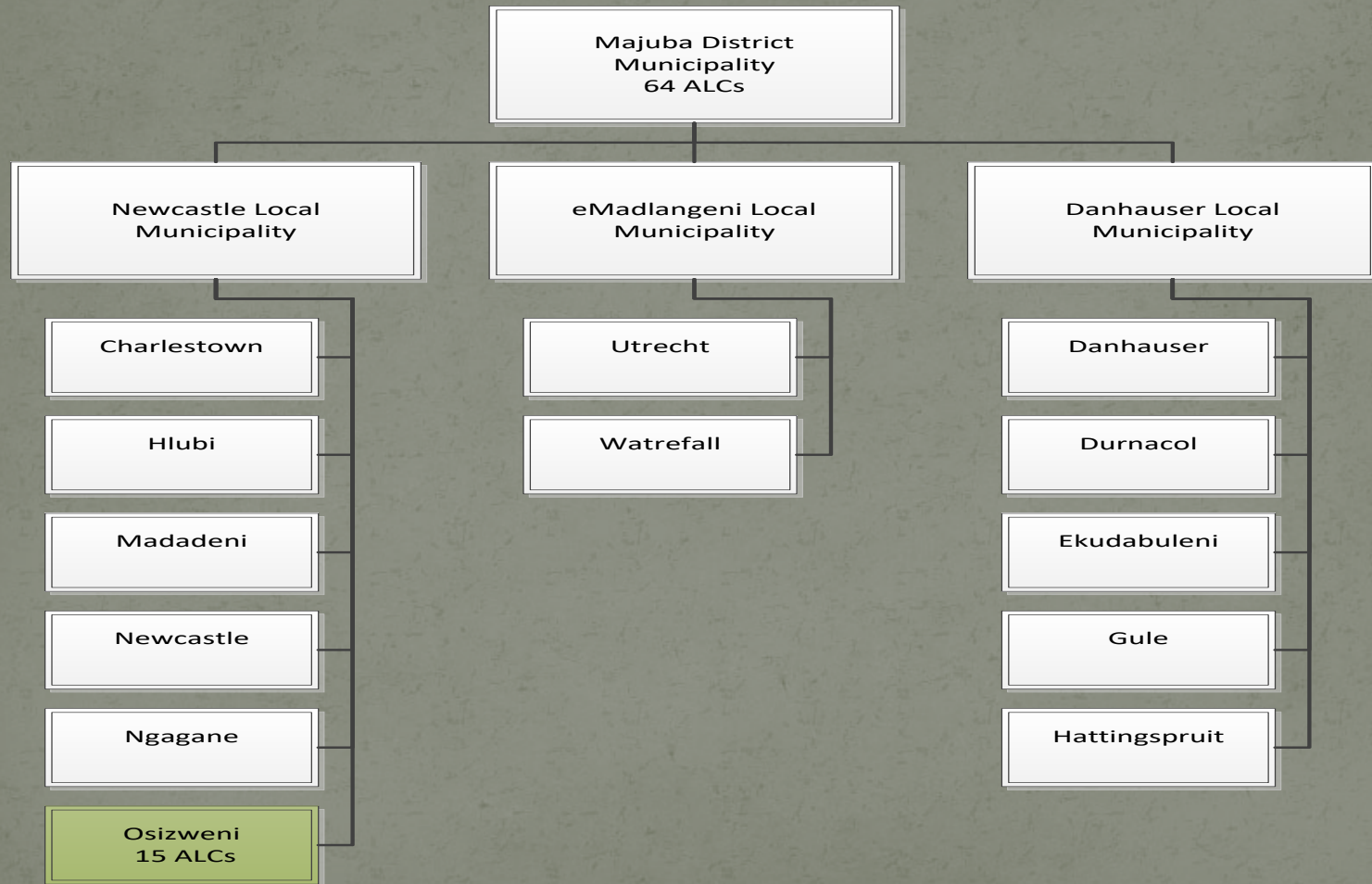
LOCATION: MAJUBA DISTRICT

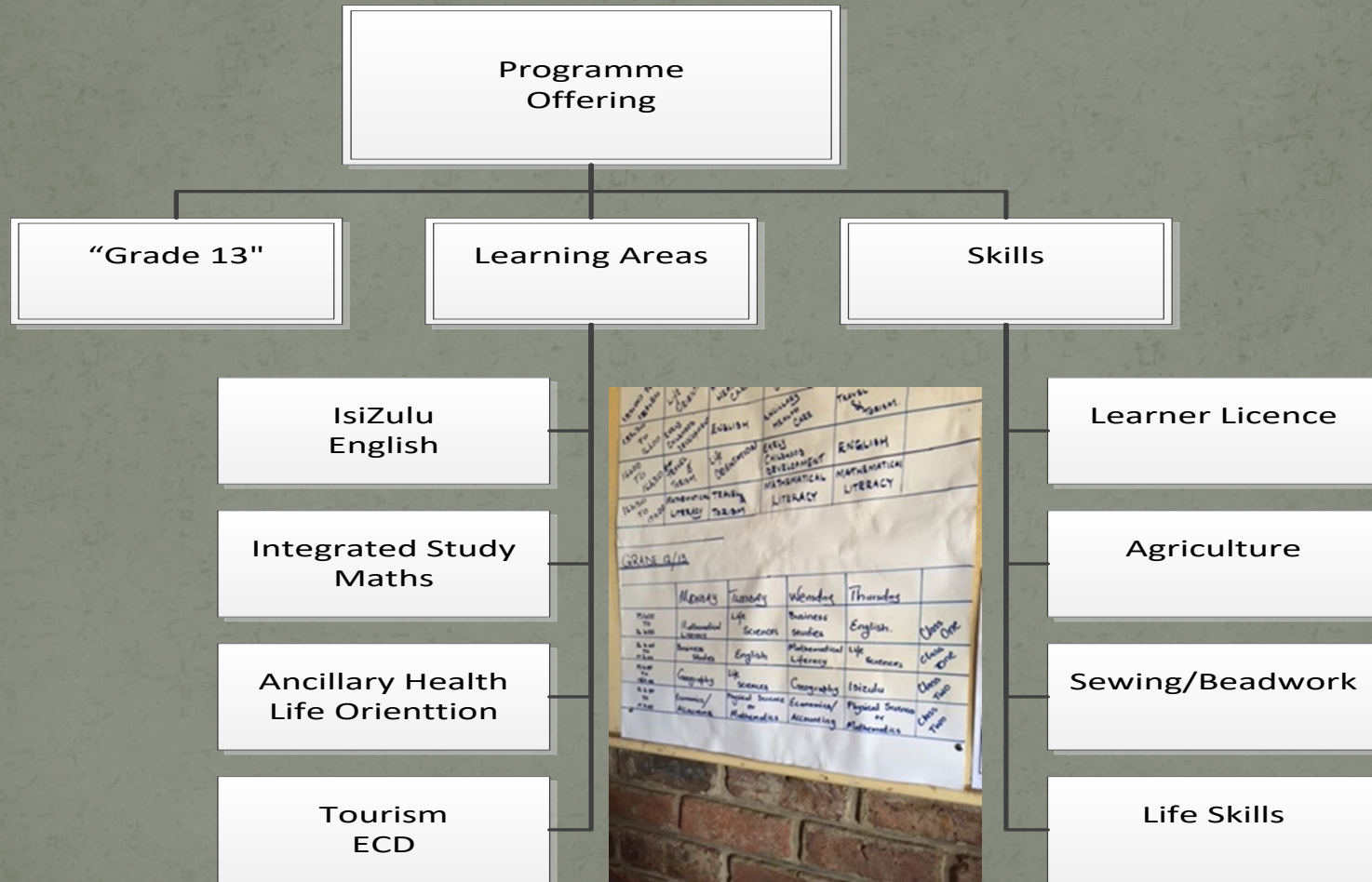

STAFF PROFILE

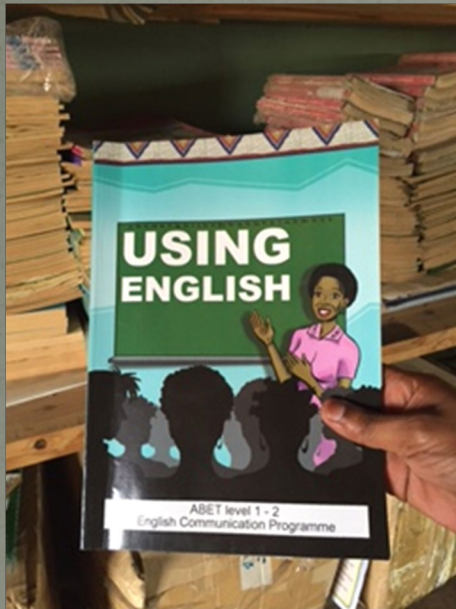
- Teaching staff not permanently employed

- End up having to train teachers every year due to turnover



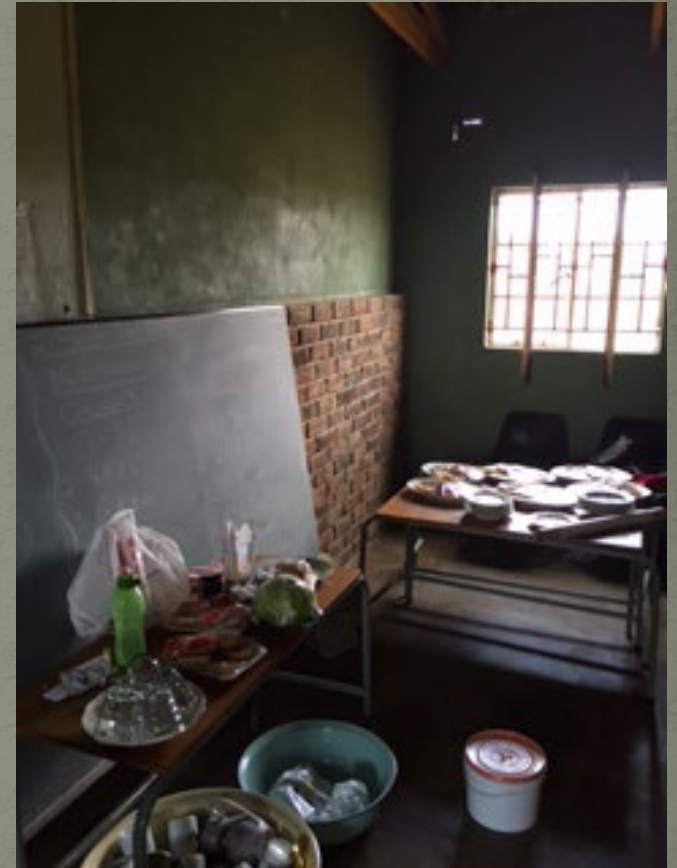
